SPA

HUMPBACK WHALE MIGRATION ROUTE

For centuries these behemoths of the deep have made their yearly pilgrimage from frigid Northern waters to their place in the sun. Watch them frolic on their winter migration path just yards off the shore.

FLAMINGO HABITAT & VIEWING SITE

Called "swanees" by 16th century explorers, flamingos are still as fragile and graceful. Here one can see them at home in their natural breeding ground of Lake Catherine—vibrant reminders of their increasing rarity.

SCUBA DIVING

SNORKELING

LAKE CATHERINE

MARINA VILLAGE

HISTORIC YANKEE TOWN SITE

The abandoned plantation community—now home to a resident pair of ospreys—was built in the late 1700s and still contains a sisal press, ruins of railroad tracks, and steam engines.

HIKING

Every day offers a new trail to discovery on this six-mile “living” museum. Stumble upon a secret cove or stranded conch shell while traipsing the entire island, tip to tip.
